

IDVD: Creating a DVD from a DV Camera

This *Quickstart* will guide you through the process of creating a DVD by importing video directly from a DV camera.

IDVD enables you to import your video from a DV camera and create a DVD disk that begins playing your movie automatically when you insert the DVD into a DVD Player.

1. Turn the computer **on**.
2. **Connect** a video camera to the computer.
3. Turn on the video camera and set the camera to **VTR or VCR** mode.
4. Open **iDVD** and select **OneStep DVD**. (You can also select this option once you open iDVD by selecting **File > OneStep DVD**).
5. Insert a recordable DVD disc into the drive on the computer.
6. iDVD rewinds the tape in the video camera and captures the video.

NOTE: Video capturing stops when the tape ends or after 10 seconds without video.

You may click on **Cancel** to stop the capture. A screen appears providing you with the option to cancel the entire process or burn the video captured up to that point.
